US 290 Westbound at 43rd St. Reopens

HOV lane returns to normal operations

The accident at US 290 at 43rd St. has been cleared. The US 290 High Occupancy Vehicle lane will return to its normal requirement for two or more passengers per vehicle.

Travelers should expect traffic in the area to remain slow until the backed-up vehicle queue is cleared.
