## **Wednesday News Conference: DA to File for First Gang Injunction**

(Houston, Tx) – District Attorney Patricia Lykos has set a news conference for 10 a.m. Wednesday to announce the filing of Harris County’s first anti-gang civil injunction, as part of a coordinated new public safety offensive against these organized crime operations.

The initial injunction targets members of the Blood and Crips gangs who have continually preyed upon the 2,400 residents of the Haverstock Hills apartment complex and its surrounding community in northeast Harris County.

Joining the District Attorney for the news conference will be representatives from the Harris County Sheriff’s Office, Aldine Independent School District Police Department, Office of Congressman Gene Green, and several community organizations and schools in that area.
