CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS CONTINUES FOR ZACHRY-ODEBRECHT PARKWAY BUILDERS

Complete closures scheduled at US 290 and US 59/I-69 for Grand Parkway construction

Construction is rapidly progressing for Segments F-1, F-2 and G of the Grand Parkway. Zachry-Odebrecht crews are continuing work at the major intersections of the 38 mile long project. Segment F1 will be performing a series of structure operations at the US 290 and Grand Parkway interchange. Work will include setting of support beams and deck panels for future ramps and bridge work for the north and south bridges over US 290.

In order to safely perform the work, **total closures of eastbound mainlanes from Roberts Road to Mason Road and westbound mainlanes from Mueschke Road to Bauer Road are scheduled nightly from 8 pm to 6 am Friday, June 20 through the end of July with the exception of Wednesday, July 2 through Sunday, July 6.** The traveling public will be detoured onto the frontage roads. Roberts Road and Bauer Road entrance ramps will be closed during the closures. The entrance ramp for SH-99 will remain open.

Segment G crews are also progressing with their work at the US 59/I-69 interchange. Crews are preparing to set beams over the southbound mainlanes. To allow for the beam setting operation, the US 59/I-69 southbound mainlanes will have a complete closure from FM 1314 to Community Drive starting at 8 pm Friday, June 20 to 6 am Monday, June 23. Motorists will be detoured to the frontage road.
